

Equipment

HIRE:

£60 per term OR £150 per year for a set of two posts.
(suitable for 16 children to play at the same time).

OR

£250 for 2 sets per year. £100 for one term.
(suitable for a whole class of 32 children on two courts)



BUY BACK SCHEME:

If you take part in this Club School Link, Harrow Korfball will reduce the cost of purchase from £780 to £580 per set of posts.

AND

If you no longer want them, we will buy back the posts in the first year at 100% (£580). This reduces to 60% in year 2.

The posts come with a 10 year warrantee. All prices include delivery.

KORFBALLS (size 4 or 5) cost £29 per ball when ordered at the same time through Harrow Korfball. We suggest ordering a minimum of 4. There is no buy back on balls.


Also available is a 'Teaching Children Korfball' Manual at £25 which includes 10 lesson plans.

WHAT IS KORFBALL?

Korfball is the **only team sport designed to be mixed, and it works.** It is fast-paced, dynamic and children love it. It will be in the **2028 Olympics.**



The principles are similar to those of netball, handball and basketball, but the unique marking, 360 degree shooting and mixed gender rules make for a much more varied game at a much faster pace.

Teams are made up of eight players with 4 boys and 4 girls.

For beginners, a Netball size court is adequate. You will need a half way line added and two posts placed 7m from the back line in each half. This allows players to shoot from 360 degrees into the 'korf', something the children really enjoy. (Netball posts are unsuitable).

The origins of the game are in The Netherlands - the word 'korf' is simply Dutch for 'basket'. School-teacher Nico Broekhuysen founded the sport in 1902 so that boys and girls could play together on equal terms, encouraging team work.
